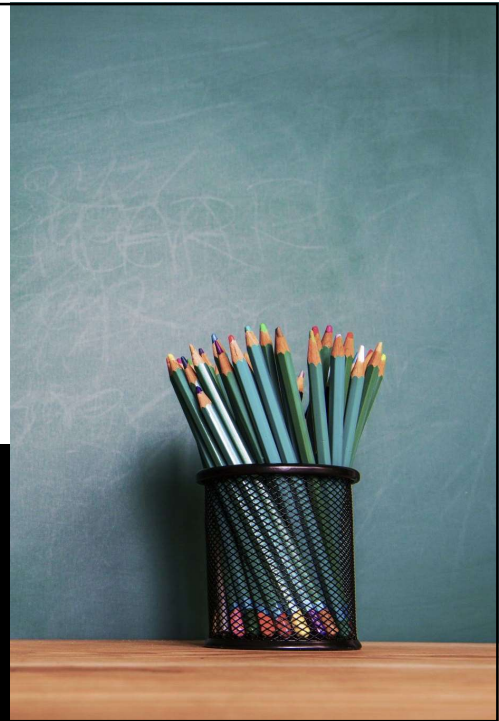

- The Pursuing Federal Funds project is a collaboration through a group of New Mexico-focused funders interested in expanding access to public funding for the nonprofit sector
- Focused on building capacity specifically to address needs related to securing complex grants and federal funding
- Federal funding industry projections indicate that the peak of bipartisan supplemental federal investments will be reached in 2028. The goal of the NM Funders' Group is to increase the number and amount of federal grant dollars awarded to New Mexico nonprofit organizations and tribal, state, and local government agencies with a focus on those traditionally left out of public funding opportunities.
